## Clinic Services

The clinic provides a safe and stable environment to address a wide array of challenges impacting youth including disruptive behavior, family conflict, anxiety, depression, adjustment to life changes, grief/loss, self-harm, suicidal ideation, trauma, and sexually maladaptive behavior.

## Home-Based Family Centered Therapy

Home-based family centered therapy is provided to those families in need of interventions in their own environment to help promote healthy functioning on an individual basis and as a family unit. The home-based therapy model focuses on the relationships of the family to ensure there are healthy attachments, parenting skills, youth development, family functioning, and positive supports. This approach is person-centered and involves the family in their treatment goals and planning process.

## Case Management

Case management services are offered to link families in need of resources to services in the community. Case management is provided to identify service needs, encourage progress, and ensure coordinated care that produces meaningful outcomes for children and families.

## Skills Training and Development

Skills training is provided to assist in teaching and enhancing skills including parenting skills, social skills, expression of feelings, communication skills, time-management, etc. Skills training promotes healthy functioning in every day life activities: school, work, home, community, etc.

## High Fidelity Wraparound

High Fidelity Wraparound is a team-based planning process intended to provide coordinated, complete, family-driven care that meets the needs of youth who are involved with multiple "systems". Systems include mental health, child welfare, juvenile justice, and special education. Wraparound services create positive change and build upon family assets.
