Keep in mind...

Due to the limitations of an outpatient clinic, families in need of emergent or urgent care should utilize their current providers or hospital for immediate services. Those in mental health crisis with no immediate danger may call the Southwestern Crisis Services Team, 24/7/365 at (812) 422–1100

Requirements:

- Must be an Indiana resident
- Age 17 or under upon referral
- Diagnosis Criteria: NDC is specially designed for youth with complex needs.
 Suspected or documented diagnoses must include a mental health disorder along with Autism Spectrum Disorder or an intellectual disability. Consideration will be given to any prior treatment interventions attempted to determine if this high level of intervention is needed.

Why Choose NDC?

NDC provides:

Care Coordination

- Friendly guidance and connection to resources
- Coordination of appointments with multiple providers
- Ongoing support to assure family needs are being met

Comprehensive Assessment with a Multidisciplinary Team that may include:

- Psychology, Psychiatry, Mental Health Services, Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy and/or Audiology
- Most assessments are coordinated at one location

Medication follow up visits with Psychiatry

- 📌 Nutrition Assessment and Counseling
- Connection to community resources and support

Ongoing visits for recommended therapies (may occur at NDC or Easterseals)
