

Tips for Family Members attending Residential Family Program

In order to visit with our clients here at our residential program, Family Education classes are mandatory.

No smoking or e-cigarette use on the grounds.

Food/drink items are prohibited. Please leave your purses and cell phones in your vehicle.

No children under the age of 14 are permitted, and number of visitors is limited to 2.

Visitors must enter the facility through the Outpatient entrance. Visitors may begin to arrive at 10:15a. After checking in, visitors will be directed to Room 236 for the educational program. Visitors who arrive after 10:35a will not be allowed to attend family program/visitation on that date.

Family Program will be for family members only, from 10:30am to 11:45am. Visitation will be from 11:45am to 12:15pm. Clients that are approved for a pass may leave after program but must return by 1:45pm.

Personal items may be brought in to patients during family visitation. Items are to be checked-in with staff when signing in.

Staff will be available during visitation for information, education, and support.

Family members can talk with staff to arrange a family therapy session and to learn more about group family sessions.
